

First Words

Psalm 111:10 - *The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom; all those who practice it have a good understanding. His praise endures forever!*

Note how the God-fearing man is like his God. Cp. **111:3 to 112:3**, **111:1 to 112:4**, and **111:3 to 112:9**.

Psalm 112:2-9 - (The results of fearing the LORD)

A. Their _____ – **Psalm 112:2** - *His offspring will be mighty in the land; the generation of the upright will be blessed.*

B. Their _____ – **Psalm 112:3** - *Wealth and riches are in his house, and his righteousness endures forever.*

C. Their _____ – **Psalm 112:4-5** - *Light dawns in the darkness for the upright; he is gracious, merciful, and righteous. It is well with the man who deals generously and lends; who conducts his affairs with justice.*

D. Their _____ – **Psalm 112:6-8** - *For the righteous will never be moved, he will be remembered forever. He is not afraid of bad news; his heart is firm, trusting in the LORD. His heart is steady; he will not be afraid, until he looks in triumph on his adversaries.*

E. Their _____ – *Psalm 112:9* - He has distributed freely; he has given to the poor; his righteousness endures forever; his horn is exalted in honor.

A. Internally - *Psalm 112:10a* - The wicked man sees it and is angry...

B. Externally - *Psalm 112:10b* - He gnashes his teeth and melts away.

C. Eternally – *Psalm 112:10c* - The desire of the wicked will perish!
