A. By example Jesus teaches us to use _____ to _____ God

Luke 4:1-2a - *And Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit in the wilderness for forty days, being tempted by the devil.*

1. In regard to the desires of the flesh - **Luke 4:3-4** - *The devil said to him, "If you are the Son of God, command this stone to become bread." And Jesus answered him, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone.'"*

2. In regard to the desires of the eyes - **Luke 4:5-8** - *And the devil took him up and showed him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time, and said to him, "To you I will give all this authority and their glory, for it has been delivered to me, and I give it to whom I will. If you, then, will worship me, it will all be yours." And Jesus answered him, "It is written, " 'You shall worship the Lord your God, and him only shall you serve.'"*

3. In regard to the pride of life - **Luke 4:9-12** - *And he took him to Jerusalem and set him on the pinnacle of the temple and said to him, "If you are the Son of God, throw yourself down from here, for it is written, " 'He will command his angels concerning you, to guard you,' and " 'On their hands they will bear you up, lest you strike your foot against a stone.'"* And Jesus answered him, "It is said, 'You shall not put the Lord your God to the test.'"

Luke 9:51 - *When the days drew near for him to be taken up, he set his face to go to Jerusalem.*

1. Jesus put His _____ with the Father before His _____ for the Father - **Luke 5:15-16** - *But now even more the report about him went abroad, and great crowds gathered to hear him and to be healed of their infirmities. But he would withdraw to desolate places and pray.*

2. Jesus put _____ before _____ - **Luke 6:6** - *On another Sabbath, he entered the synagogue and was teaching, and a man was there whose right hand was withered.*

Luke 22:41-42 - *And he withdrew from them about a stone's throw, and knelt down and prayed, saying, "Father, if you are willing, remove this cup from me. Nevertheless, not my will, but yours, be done."*

1. Jesus' _____ - **John 18:11** - *So Jesus said to Peter, "Put your sword into its sheath; shall I not drink the cup that the Father has given me?"*

2. Jesus' _____ - **Mark 14:36** - *And he said, "Abba, Father, all things are possible for you. Remove this cup from me. Yet not what I will, but what you will." (F.A.I.T.H)*

D. By example Jesus teaches us to use _____ to _____ God

1. The _____ against Jesus - **Luke 23:33–34** - *And when they came to the place that is called The Skull, there they crucified him, and the criminals, one on his right and one on his left. And Jesus said, “Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do.” And they cast lots to divide his garments.*

2. The _____ of Jesus - **1 Peter 2:21–23** - *For to this you have been called, because Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example, so that you might follow in his steps. He committed no sin, neither was deceit found in his mouth. When he was reviled, he did not revile in return; when he suffered, he did not threaten, but continued entrusting himself to him who judges justly.*

The _____ of Jesus Christ

A. When on the earth , Jesus was _____ by the Holy Spirit - **Luke 4:1 & 14** - *And Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit in the wilderness...And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit to Galilee, and a report about him went out through all the surrounding country.*

B. While on this earth, we too can be _____ by the Holy Spirit – **Luke 11:11–13** - *What father among you, if his son asks for a fish, will instead of a fish give him a serpent; ¹² or if he asks for an egg, will give him a scorpion? ¹³ If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!”*
