Jesus Christ and listening to God’s Word

Jesus listened as a disciple and grew - **Luke 2:46–47 & 52** - *After three days they found him in the temple, sitting among the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions.* ⁴⁷ *And all who heard him were amazed at his understanding and his answers....*⁵² *And Jesus increased in wisdom and in stature and in favor with God and man.* - cp. **Luke 9:35**

Jesus’ words and God’s word are synonymous - **Luke 5:1** - *On one occasion, while the crowd was pressing in on him to hear the word of God, he was standing by the lake of Gennesaret – see also **Luke 21:33***

Jesus’ words should be listened to and applied producing stability -**Luke 6:47–48** - *Everyone who comes to me and hears my words and does them, I will show you what he is like:* ⁴⁸ *he is like a man building a house, who dug deep and laid the foundation on the rock. And when a flood arose, the stream broke against that house and could not shake it, because it had been well built. – See **Luke 4:4,8, &12***

Jesus’ words should be listened to and held fast to producing fruit - **Luke 8:15** - *As for that in the good soil, they are those who, hearing the word, hold it fast in an honest and good heart, and bear fruit with patience.*
