Acts 2:1 - When the day of Pentecost arrived, they were all together in one place.

It came out of a time of great _____ – The Crucifixion, Resurrection and Ascension - *Acts 1:1–3 - In the first book, O Theophilus, I have dealt with all that Jesus began to do and teach, ² until the day when he was taken up, after he had given commands through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen. ³ He presented himself alive to them after his suffering by many proofs, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God.*

It came out a time of great _____ -*Acts 1:4–5 - And while staying with them he ordered them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father, which, he said, “you heard from me; ⁵ for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now.”*

3. It came at a time of great _____ - *Acts 1:8 - “But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”*

4. It came at a time of great _____ -*Acts 1:9–11 -And when he had said these things, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him out of their sight. ¹⁰ And while they were gazing into heaven as he went, behold, two men stood by them in white robes, ¹¹ and said, “Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven? This Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven.”*

5. It came at a time of great _____ - *Acts 1:12 & 14 - Then they returned to Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet, which is near Jerusalem, a Sabbath day’s journey away. ... All these with one accord were devoting themselves to prayer, together with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and his brothers.*

6. It came at a time of great _____ - *Acts 1:14 & 2:1 - All these with one accord were..... they were all together in one place*

7. It came at a time of great _____ - *Exodus 23:14–17 - “Three times in the year you shall keep a feast to me.¹⁵ You shall keep the Feast of Unleavened Bread....¹⁶ You shall keep the Feast of Harvest.... You shall keep the Feast of Ingathering...¹⁷ Three times in the year shall all your males appear before the Lord GOD.*

Acts 2:2-4 - And suddenly there came from heaven a sound like a mighty rushing wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. ³ And divided tongues as of fire appeared to them and rested on each one of them. ⁴ And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance.

The _____ - **Acts 2:8-11** - *And how is it that we hear, each of us in his own native language? ⁹ Parthians and Medes and Elamites and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia ¹⁰ Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya belonging to Cyrene, and visitors from Rome, ¹¹ both Jews and proselytes, Cretans and Arabians—we hear them telling in our own tongues the mighty works of God."*
