A. \_\_\_\_\_ in a Whole New World

1. God \_\_\_\_\_ Us – We \_\_\_\_\_ on Him

**Genesis 8:1–2** - *But God remembered Noah and all the beasts and all the livestock that were with him in the ark. And God made a wind blow over the earth, and the waters subsided. <sup>2</sup> The fountains of the deep and the windows of the heavens were closed, the rain from the heavens was restrained...*

**Genesis 8:6–9** - *At the end of forty days Noah opened the window of the ark that he had made <sup>7</sup> and sent forth a raven. It went to and fro until the waters were dried up from the earth. <sup>8</sup> Then he sent forth a dove from him, to see if the waters had subsided from the face of the ground. <sup>9</sup> But the dove found no place to set her foot, and she returned to him to the ark, for the waters were still on the face of the whole earth. So he put out his hand and took her and brought her into the ark with him. – See **Genesis 8:18 & 12***

2. God \_\_\_\_\_ Us – We \_\_\_\_\_ Him

**Genesis 8:16–18** - *“Go out from the ark, you and your wife, and your sons and your sons’ wives with you. <sup>17</sup> Bring out with you every living thing that is with you of all flesh—birds and animals and every creeping thing that creeps on the earth—that they may swarm on the earth and be fruitful and multiply on the earth.” <sup>18</sup> So Noah went out, and his sons and his wife and his sons’ wives with him.*

**Genesis 8:20** - *Then Noah built an altar to the LORD and took some of every clean animal and some of every clean bird and offered burnt offerings on the altar.*

3. God \_\_\_\_\_ Us – We \_\_\_\_\_ Him

**Genesis 9:1–3** - *And God blessed Noah and his sons and said to them, “Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth. <sup>2</sup> The fear of you and the dread of you shall be upon every beast of the earth and upon every bird of the heavens, upon everything that creeps on the ground and all the fish of the sea. Into your hand they are delivered. <sup>3</sup> Every moving thing that lives shall be food for you. And as I gave you the green plants, I give you everything.*

**Genesis 9:7** - *And you, be fruitful and multiply, increase greatly on the earth and multiply in it.”*

4. God \_\_\_\_\_ with Us – We \_\_\_\_\_ Him

**Genesis 9:11–13** - *I establish my covenant with you, that never again shall all flesh be cut off by the waters of the flood, and never again shall there be a flood to destroy the earth.” <sup>12</sup> And God said, “This is the sign of the covenant that I make between me and you and every living creature that is with you, for all future generations: <sup>13</sup> I have set my bow in the cloud, and it shall be a sign of the covenant between me and the earth.*

**Genesis 9:16–17** - *When the bow is in the clouds, I will see it and remember the everlasting covenant between God and every living creature of all flesh that is on the earth.” <sup>17</sup> God said to Noah, “This is the sign of the covenant that I have established between me and all flesh that is on the earth.”*

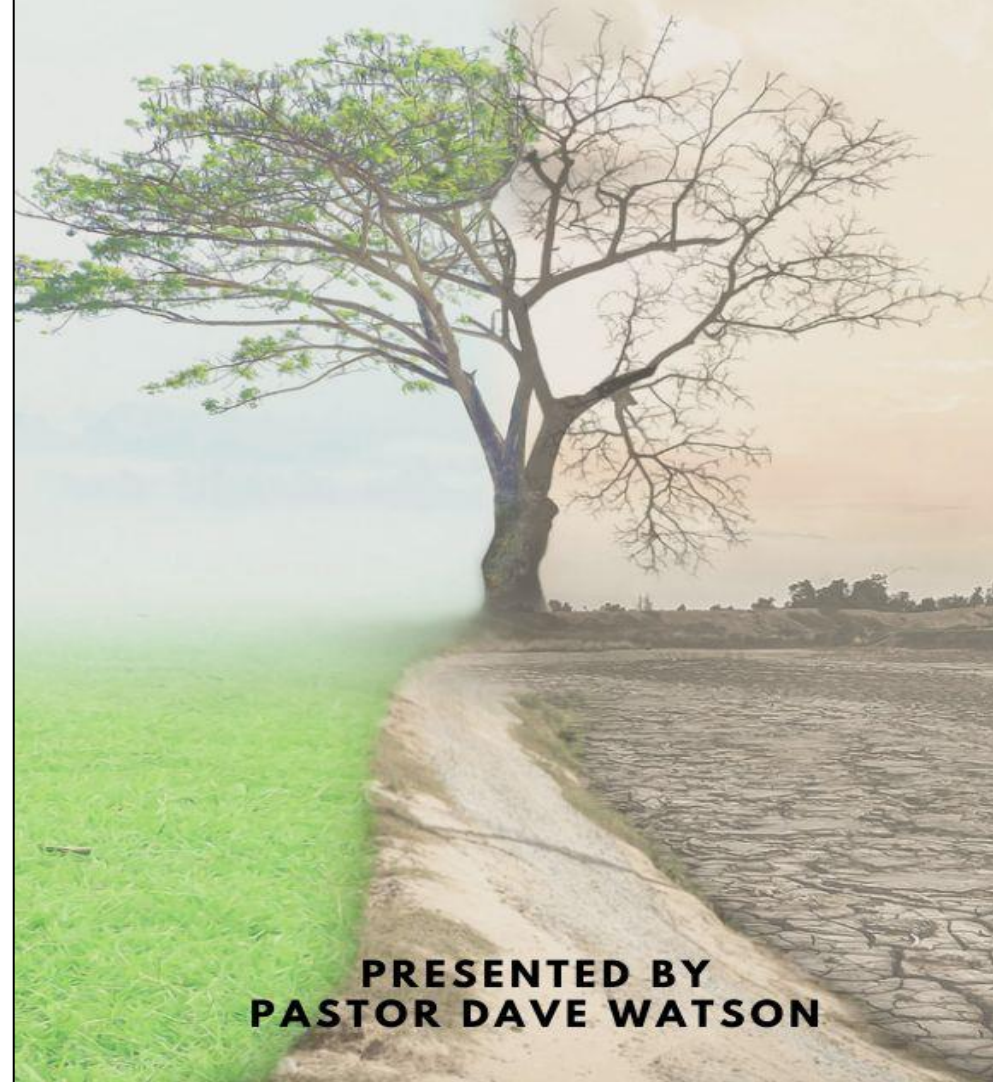
B. \_\_\_\_\_ in a Whole New World

1. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Noah - **Genesis 9:20–21** - *Noah began to be a man of the soil, and he planted a vineyard. <sup>21</sup> He drank of the wine and became drunk and lay uncovered in his tent.*
2. The \_\_\_\_\_ for Noah - **Genesis 9:22** - *And Ham, the father of Canaan, saw the nakedness of his father and told his two brothers outside.*
3. The \_\_\_\_\_ over Noah - **Genesis 9:23** - *Then Shem and Japheth took a garment, laid it on both their shoulders, and walked backward and covered the nakedness of their father. Their faces were turned backward, and they did not see their father's nakedness.*
4. The \_\_\_\_\_ from Noah - **Genesis 9:24–25** - *When Noah awoke from his wine and knew what his youngest son had done to him, <sup>25</sup> he said, "Cursed be Canaan; a servant of servants shall he be to his brothers."*
5. The \_\_\_\_\_ by Noah - **Genesis 9:26–27** - *He also said, "Blessed be the LORD, the God of Shem; and let Canaan be his servant. <sup>27</sup> May God enlarge Japheth, and let him dwell in the tents of Shem, and let Canaan be his servant."*
6. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Noah - **Genesis 9:28–29** - *After the flood Noah lived 350 years. <sup>29</sup> All the days of Noah were 950 years, and he died.*
