

\_\_\_\_\_ – **Genesis 34:1-31**

A. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Jacob’s daughter – **Genesis 34:1-4**

**Genesis 34:1–2** - Now Dinah the daughter of Leah, whom she had borne to Jacob, went out to see the women of the land. <sup>2</sup> And when Shechem the son of Hamor the Hivite, the prince of the land, saw her, he seized her and lay with her and humiliated her.

B. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Jacob’s family – **Genesis 34:5-7**

1. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Jacob – **Genesis 34:5–6** - Now Jacob heard that he had defiled his daughter Dinah. But his sons were with his livestock in the field, so Jacob held his peace until they came. <sup>6</sup> And Hamor the father of Shechem went out to Jacob to speak with him.

2. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Jacob’s sons - **Genesis 34:7** - The sons of Jacob had come in from the field as soon as they heard of it, and the men were indignant and very angry, because he had done an outrageous thing in Israel by lying with Jacob’s daughter, for such a thing must not be done.

3. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Jacob’s sons – **Genesis 34:8-25**

a. The desperate plea – **Genesis 34:8–10** - But Hamor spoke with them, saying, “The soul of my son Shechem longs for your daughter. Please give her to him to be his wife. <sup>9</sup> Make marriages with us. Give your daughters to us, and take our daughters for yourselves. <sup>10</sup> You shall dwell with us, and the land shall be open to you. Dwell and trade in it, and get property in it.”

b. The deceitful plot - **Genesis 34:14–15** - They said to them, “We cannot do this thing, to give our sister to one who is uncircumcised, for that would be a disgrace to us. <sup>15</sup> Only on this condition will we agree with you—that you will become as we are by every male among you being circumcised.

C. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Jacob’s sons – **Genesis 34:25-29**

1. The \_\_\_\_\_ of the men - **Genesis 34:25–26** - On the third day, when they were sore, two of the sons of Jacob, Simeon and Levi, Dinah’s brothers, took their swords and came against the city while it felt secure and killed all the males. <sup>26</sup> They killed Hamor and his son Shechem with the sword and took Dinah out of Shechem’s house and went away.

2. The \_\_\_\_\_ of the city - **Genesis 34:28–29** - They took their flocks and their herds, their donkeys, and whatever was in the city and in the field. <sup>29</sup> All their wealth, all their little ones and their wives, all that was in the houses, they captured and plundered.

D. The \_\_\_\_\_ concerning Jacob – **Genesis 34:30-31**

**Genesis 34:30–31** -Then Jacob said to Simeon and Levi, “You have brought trouble on me by making me stink to the inhabitants of the land, the Canaanites and the Perizzites. My numbers are few, and if they gather themselves against me and attack me, I shall be destroyed, both I and my household.” <sup>31</sup> But they said, “Should he treat our sister like a prostitute?”

\_\_\_\_\_ – **Genesis 35:1-15**

A. The \_\_\_\_\_ to Bethel – **Genesis 35:1**

**Genesis 35:1** - God said to Jacob, “Arise, go up to Bethel and dwell there. Make an altar there to the God who appeared to you when you fled from your brother Esau.”

B. The \_\_\_\_\_ before Bethel – **Genesis 35:2-4**

**Genesis 35:2–3** - So Jacob said to his household and to all who were with him, “Put away the foreign gods that are among you and purify yourselves and change your garments. <sup>3</sup> Then let us arise and go up to Bethel, so that I may make there an altar to the God who answers me in the day of my distress and has been with me wherever I have gone.”

C. The \_\_\_\_\_ at Bethel – **Genesis 35:5-16**

1. God \_\_\_\_\_ to Jacob - **Genesis 35:10–11** - *And God said to him, “Your name is Jacob; no longer shall your name be called Jacob, but Israel shall be your name.” So he called his name Israel. <sup>11</sup> And God said to him, “I am God Almighty: be fruitful and multiply. A nation and a company of nations shall come from you, and kings shall come from your own body.*

2. Jacob \_\_\_\_\_ God - **Genesis 35:13–14** - *Then God went up from him in the place where he had spoken with him. <sup>14</sup> And Jacob set up a pillar in the place where he had spoken with him, a pillar of stone. He poured out a drink offering on it and poured oil on it.*

\_\_\_\_\_ - **Genesis 35:16-29**

The painful \_\_\_\_\_ - **Genesis 35:17–18** - *And when her labor was at its hardest, the midwife said to her, “Do not fear, for you have another son.” <sup>18</sup> And as her soul was departing (for she was dying), she called his name Ben-oni; but his father called him Benjamin.*

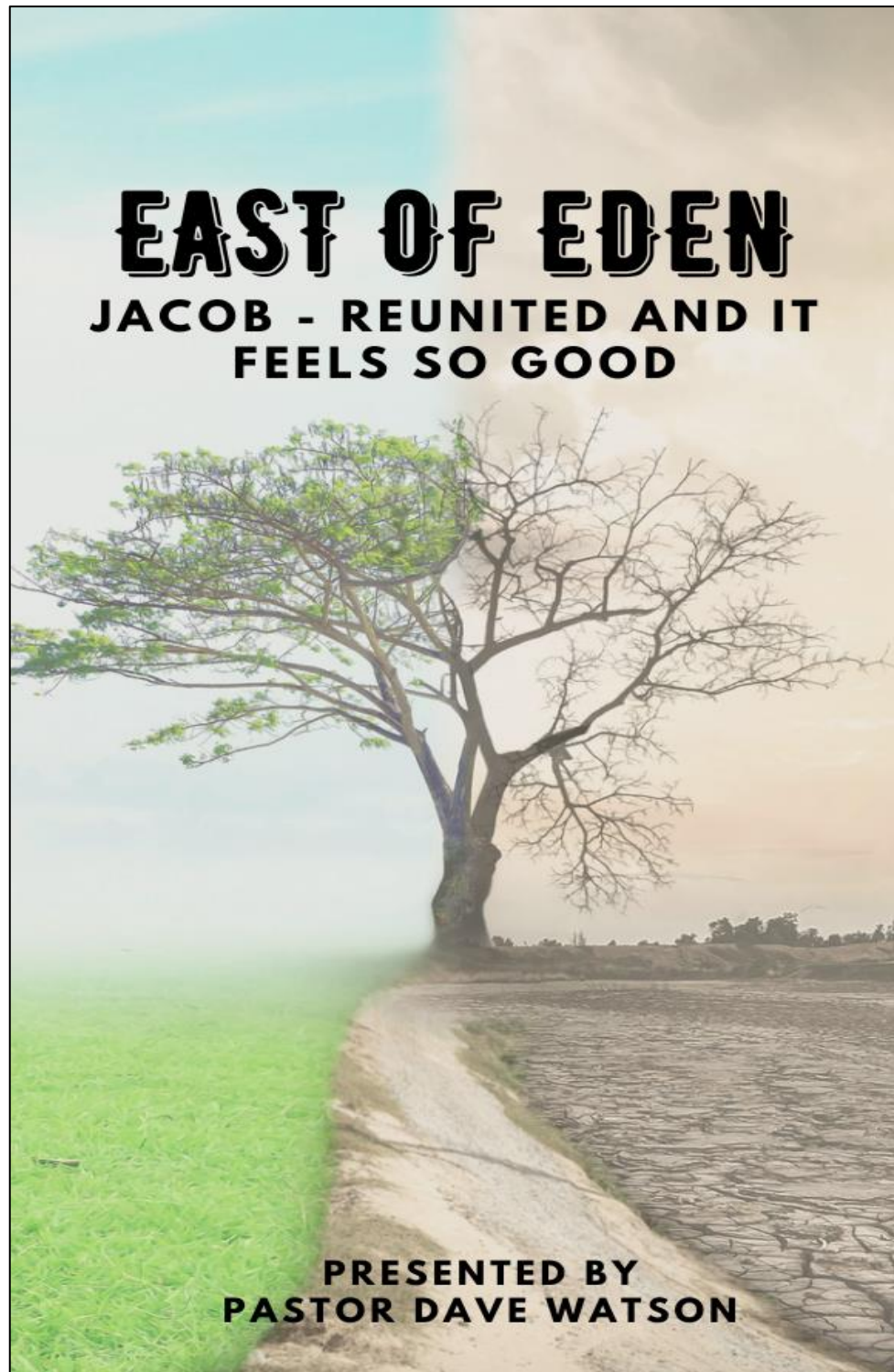
The painful \_\_\_\_\_ - **Genesis 35:22** - *While Israel lived in that land, Reuben went and lay with Bilhah his father’s concubine. And Israel heard of it. Now the sons of Jacob were twelve.*

The painful \_\_\_\_\_ - **Genesis 35:28–29** - *Now the days of Isaac were 180 years. <sup>29</sup> And Isaac breathed his last, and he died and was gathered to his people, old and full of days. And his sons Esau and Jacob buried him.*

\_\_\_\_\_ – **Genesis 36:1-43**

**Genesis 36:6–8** - *Then Esau took his wives, his sons, his daughters, and all the members of his household, his livestock, all his beasts, and all his property that he had acquired in the land of Canaan. He went into a land away from his brother Jacob. <sup>7</sup> For their possessions were too great*
