The ______ for the Trumpet Judgments – *Revelation 8:1-6*

A. The ______ in heaven – *Revelation 8:1* - When the Lamb opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven for about half an hour.

B. The ______ of trumpets - *Revelation 8:2 & 6 - Then I saw* the seven angels who stand before God and seven trumpets were given to them...⁶ Now the seven angels who had the seven trumpets prepared to blow them.

C. The of incense - *Revelation 8:3-4* - *And another* angel came and stood at the altar with a golden censer, and he was given much incense to offer with the prayers of all the saints on the golden altar before the throne, ⁴ and the smoke of the incense, with the prayers of the saints, rose before God from the hand of the angel.

D. The of earth – *Revelation 8:5* - *Then the angel* took the censer and filled it with fire from the altar and threw it on the earth, and there were peals of thunder, rumblings, flashes of lightning, and an earthquake.

The ______ about the Trumpet Judgments – *Revelation 8:7-9:19*.

A. The First Trumpet – ______ - *Revelation 8:7* - *The first* angel blew his trumpet, and there followed hail and fire, mixed with blood, and these were thrown upon the earth. And a third of the earth was burned up, and a third of the trees were burned up, and all green grass was burned up.

B. The Second Trumpet – _____ - *Revelation 8:8–9* - *The* second angel blew his trumpet, and something like a great mountain, burning with fire, was thrown into the sea, and a third of the sea became blood. ⁹ A third of the living creatures in the sea died, and a third of the ships were destroyed.

C. The Third Trumpet – _____ - *Revelation 8:10–11* - *The* third angel blew his trumpet, and a great star fell from heaven, blazing like a torch, and it fell on a third of the rivers and on the springs of water. ¹¹ The name of the star is Wormwood. A third of the waters became wormwood, and many people died from the water, because it had been made bitter.

D. The Fourth Trumpet – _____ - *Revelation 8:12* - *The* fourth angel blew his trumpet, and a third of the sun was struck, and a third of the moon, and a third of the stars, so that a third of their light might be darkened, and a third of the day might be kept from shining, and likewise a third of the night.

The _____ Warning of the Trumpet Judgements - Revelation 8:13

Revelation 8:13 - Then I looked, and I heard an eagle crying with a loud voice as it flew directly overhead, "Woe, woe, woe to those who dwell on the earth, at the blasts of the other trumpets that the three angels are about to blow!"

E. The Fifth Trumpet – _____ – *Revelation 9:1-12*

Revelation 9:1, 3, &6 - And the fifth angel blew his trumpet, and I saw a star fallen from heaven to earth, and he was given the key to the shaft of the bottomless pit...³ Then from the smoke came locusts on the earth, and they were given power like the power of scorpions of the earth...⁶ And in those days people will seek death and will not find it. They will long to die, but death will flee from them.

F. The Sixth Trumpet – _____ – *Revelation 9:13-18*

Revelation 9:13, 15 &18 - Then the sixth angel blew his trumpet, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar before God....¹⁵ So the four angels, who had been prepared for the hour, the day, the month, and the year, were released to kill a third of mankind...¹⁸ By these three plagues a third of mankind was killed, by the fire and smoke and sulfur coming out of their mouths.

The ______ toward the Trumpet Judgments – *Revelation 9:20-21*

Revelation 9:20–21 - The rest of mankind, who were not killed by these plagues, did not repent of the works of their hands nor give up worshiping demons and idols of gold and silver and bronze and stone and wood, which cannot see or hear or walk, ²¹ nor did they repent of their murders or their sorceries or their sexual immorality or their thefts.
